- Nominees must have maintained exemplary standards of behavior and ethics, exhibited leadership, been enthusiastic about their role within the school, demonstrated competency in their subject matter or job area, worked well with colleagues and consistently sought to encourage, inspire and motivate students toward greater accomplishment.
- Nominees must have shown consistent involvement outside of the classroom, such as a sponsor of extracurricular activity or coach, community service, or other substantial contributions to the school community.
