Dr. Seaton reviewed the FY2019 & FY2020 Bond Issues & Capital Project Finance Tracker spreadsheet which reflects the status of the revenue and expenditures of the bonds to date. The spreadsheet reflects approximately \$2,249,000 available for Phase 2 of the Health Life Safety projects.

Administrative Reports

Superintendent:

• Preliminary Property Tax Resolution – Dr. Seaton presented the preliminary property tax statistics which indicated the property growth (EAV) is expected to slightly increase, approximately 4.18% (.0418). The tax levy, as presented by Dr. Seaton, would result in a slight decrease in the tax rate for the upcoming year. SHS is estimated to receive approximately \$200,000 more in 2020-21 than in 2019-20 from property tax dollars. The final Levy will be presented for approval at the December 17, 2019, SHS Board of Education meeting. Dr. Seaton recommended the Board approve the Preliminary Property Tax Levy at a 6% increase in EAV to assure all funds possible are available to the District.

- ISBE Property Tax Relief Grant The Property Tax Relief Grant is part of the recent school funding reform. Grant recipients are ranked by a formula set by the ISBE. Should the District apply for and receive the grant, the District could abate up to \$471,791 off the property taxes for next year. Dr. Seaton recommended the Board approve the grant application.
- <u>Bid Letting for Summer 2020 Projects</u> Dr. Seaton reviewed with the Board, the list of the upcoming Summer, 2020 Health Life Safety projects including, but not limited to, 5 roofs areas, HVAC (with A/C) in the Pops Dale Gym, replacement of 43 interior doors, removal of the balcony bleachers and construct a wall, replace lintels in rooms 114/115, and replace the A/C units over the Superintendent's office areas. Dr. Seaton recommended the Board authorize the bid letting for the projects.
- <u>Transportation Contract Renewal</u> The current transportation contract with Illinois Central is set to expire June 30, 2019. Illinois Central has proposed to extend the contract one additional year at a 2.95% increase in fees. Dr. Seaton recommended the Board approve the proposed 1-year extension to the contract.
- <u>e-Learning Program Resolution</u> The e-Learning Program Public Hearing was held at 5:45 p.m. this date. In order for the District to use e-Learning Days in lieu of emergency days, the Board must adopt the e-Learning Program Resolution. In addition to the Resolution, Dr. Seaton and the Board reviewed the Verification Form and FAQ document which was previously submitted to the Regional Office of Education. Dr. Seaton recommended the Board adopt the Resolution.
- <u>Activity Account Diversity Club</u> Diversity Club Advisor, Mr. Nugent, submitted a request for an Activity Account to manage funds generated by the Diversity Club Program.
- PRESS Board Policy Updates #102 First Reading The Board reviewed and discussed the proposed updates to the STHS School Board Policies.

- <u>2019-2020 Early Graduates</u> The Guidance Department submitted the proposed list of December, 2019, early graduates for an initial review. It is expected that all of the proposed graduates will have completed all of the graduation requirements by the end of the first semester of the 2019-2020 school year.
