e-Learning Program Review


In order for the District to utilize e-Learning Days in lieu of Emergency Days, a Public Hearing must be held and the Board must adopt the e-Learning Program Resolution. Dr. Seaton and the Board reviewed the Resolution and discussed the various procedures performed during an eLearning Day. The Resolution is valid for three years and includes a maximum of 5 e-Learning Days per school year. An e-Learning Day allows the students to continue to have instruction, at home, via their chromebook during an emergency day. The students will have at least 5 hours of instruction and/or work to be performed during the e-Learning Day which meets the requirement of a school day. Since the e-Learning day qualifies as a school day, it will not need be made up by extending the school year. Dr. Seaton recommended the Board approve the e-Learning Program Resolution during the Regular Board of Education Meeting of November 19, 2019.
